

NORTH KINGSTOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING OVERVIEW

The North Kingstown Town Council had its first of two October meetings on Monday evening, October 6th, in Council Chambers at Town Hall (80 Boston Neck Rd). The next meeting, which is expected to have a busy agenda, will be on Monday, October 20th in the same location.

The meeting began with an opportunity for public comment. This is the portion of the meeting providing residents with an opportunity to comment on issues within the agenda as well as any issues that may not be on the agenda. Town Council asks that those wishing to speak respectfully limit their comments to three minutes or less.

The Town Council unanimously approved the bid award and funding for the Water Department's installation of inline and insertion valves and a hydrant replacement in the Ten Rod Road and School Street areas, as well as for the relocation and replacement of a fire hydrant on Phillips Street in conjunction with the mini-roundabout installation in Wickford Village. The Town Council scheduled upcoming public hearings on an amended fee schedule relative to Police Department Fees; updated fee schedule for the Municipal Golf Course, as recommended by the Leisure Services Advisory Committee; and an updated fee schedule for Allen Harbor, also as recommended by Leisure Services Advisory Committee.

In addition to accepting with gratitude a donation to the Beechwood Senior Center, Town Council also authorized licenses for the Lafayette Band and the upcoming VFW Fall Festival at the North Kingstown Municipal Parking Lot on Brown Street in Wickford on October 18th. In concluding their official business, Town Council unanimously supported the Planning Department's request to apply to the Rhode Island of Environmental Management for a 2025 Municipality Beautification Mini Grant.

The meeting concluded with the Town Manager providing another [Manager's Report](#) for Town Council and the public on updates and information for the many projects and events currently taking place. The Report featured many updates, including on the: School Department's Bond Projects, Public Safety Complex Bond Projects, Wickford Municipal Parking Lot project, RIDOT communications updates regarding the Route 4 traffic signal, upcoming Post Road/West Main Street sidewalk project, events, information sessions, and a preview of items on the October 20th meeting agenda.

The meeting was adjourned following an update on correspondence by Council Person Linnea Drew.
