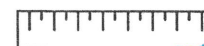
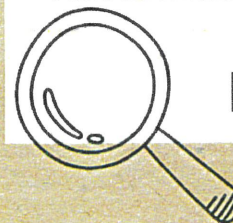


## WHY REGISTER
