Recycling Service Guidelines

- Recycling will be collected once every other week between 6 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- Only designated North Kingstown 96-gallon carts must be used for recycling collection.
- Place your carts at the curb the night before your scheduled collection or by **6 a.m.** the day of your pickup.
- See the adjacent panel for acceptable recyclable materials. For a more detailed listing, visit www.rirrc.org/mixed-recycling or www.northkingstown.org/246/Recycling
- You do not need to sort your recyclables. All recycling should be loose in the cart. Do NOT crush recyclables inside cart.

The following items are NOT acceptable in your recycling cart

- Do not place recyclables in a bag.
- Do not place any type of plastic bags in your recycling cart.
- Do not place trash, propane tanks, scrap metal, or hazardous waste in your recycling cart.
- Do not place shredded paper in your recycling cart.

North Kingstown Transfer Station

Residents are invited to drop off any excess recycling (free of charge). Fees may apply for any of the acceptable materials noted below at the North Kingstown Transfer Station located at **345 Devils Foot Road**.

Hours of Operation

Tuesday, Friday and Saturday - 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Acceptable Items Include

- Residential household waste in bags with North Kingstown tag.
- Metal, brush, wood waste, demolition material, appliances (without refrigerant), and bulky items (those that do not fit in a 34 gallon bag).
- Appliances with refrigerant (e.g. refrigerator, air conditioner, freezer, and dehumidifier).
- Recyclable mattresses and box springs limited to 2- sets per day. Mattresses that are non-recyclable will be charged a \$70 per item disposal fee. Residents are required to stop at the scale house for inspection.
- Leaves and grass clippings-no charge to residents.
- Tires, without the rims (maximum of 4).
- Recyclable materials, e.g. metal cans, plastic containers less than 5-gal (liquid ounce), glass, corrugated cardboard (flattened), newspapers, mixed paper, rigid plastics, used motor oil, batteries, used books and clothing, Christmas trees (seasonal) - at no charge to residents.
- Propane tanks.

Cart Placement for Recycling Collection

- Place your carts at least 3 feet apart and 3 feet away from any obstacles (trees, cars, mailboxes, etc.) to allow the automatic arm to lift and empty the cart. Place the wheels of cart toward the house.
