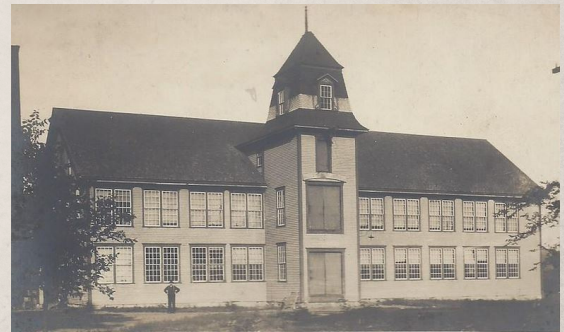


## The Villages of North Kingstown:

# THE STORY OF DAVISVILLE

In this talk, Loxton will recount that history, covering the original land purchases of the 1600s, the arrival of Joshua Davis in 1694, the development of the “Davis Mills” settlement in the 1700s, and the growth and decline of a vibrant and complete mill village in the 19th and 20th centuries.
